- not already on a Capital investment programme
- not a maintenance repair (landlord responsibility)
- any owners need to agree to the work being done and pay their share
- the cost for the work should be value for money

Dunswin Court raised planters. Two planters of similar design to the one below. Planters come filled with good quality soil. Estimated cost £1500. Actual quote received after meeting £1400. This proposal is subject to approval from Scottish Fire and Rescue. **All in favour to proceed with proposal.**



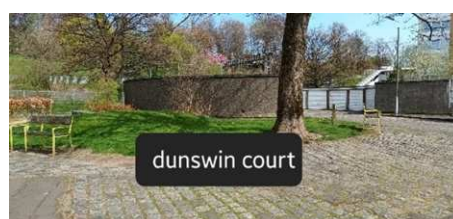

Dennystoun Forge football pitch refurbishment. The pitch needs upgraded and there are plans to do so on the next 18 months to 24 months. The pitch is currently unsafe as there is a large hole in the pitch and children are at risk. Children living at Dennystoun Forge are unable to play in it. Quote received £5600. **All in favour to proceed with proposal.**

Dalmuir Multi Storey Flats benches need cleaned. The benches have been in situ for several years and are covered in lichen, bird droppings. Quote received for £200. **All in favour to proceed with proposal.**
